(I) - Process

Preparation of the post-2020 global biodiversity framework - What is already agreed (XIII/1; XIII/29; XIII/23; XIII/24; XIII/27)

- Summary of major steps for SP 2011-2020 (pre 2010)
- Links: to GBO-5, long-term strategic framework for capacity-building, other biodiversity-related Conventions and SDGs
- Future of national reporting (possible alignment with Protocols)
- Include a timetable,
- Take into consideration that the plan must cover the Convention on Biological Diversity and also consider its Protocols, as appropriate,
- Include options for fostering commitments and strengthened implementation,
- Take into account the preparation of the fifth edition of the *Global Biodiversity Outlook*, the final assessment of the implementation of the Strategic Plan for Biodiversity 2011-2020,⁴ national reports, and the thematic, regional and global assessments of the Intergovernmental Science-Policy Platform on Biodiversity and Ecosystem Services,
- Provide for consultations among Parties, and with other Rio Conventions, other biodiversity-related multilateral environmental agreements, and inputs from indigenous peoples and local communities and relevant stakeholders and sectors.

 - Capacity building

- What of the current plan will remain relevant? What will need to be updated and/or replaced and how will it be done? (vision, goals, targets)
- Maintaining and enhancing means for implementation including resource mobilization
- Maintaining and enhancing review of implementation (monitoring, indicators, reporting)
- Enhance the relevance to the other biodiversity-related conventions
- Links major global agendas (SDGs, Paris Agreement, land degradation neutrality,...)
- Voluntary commitments

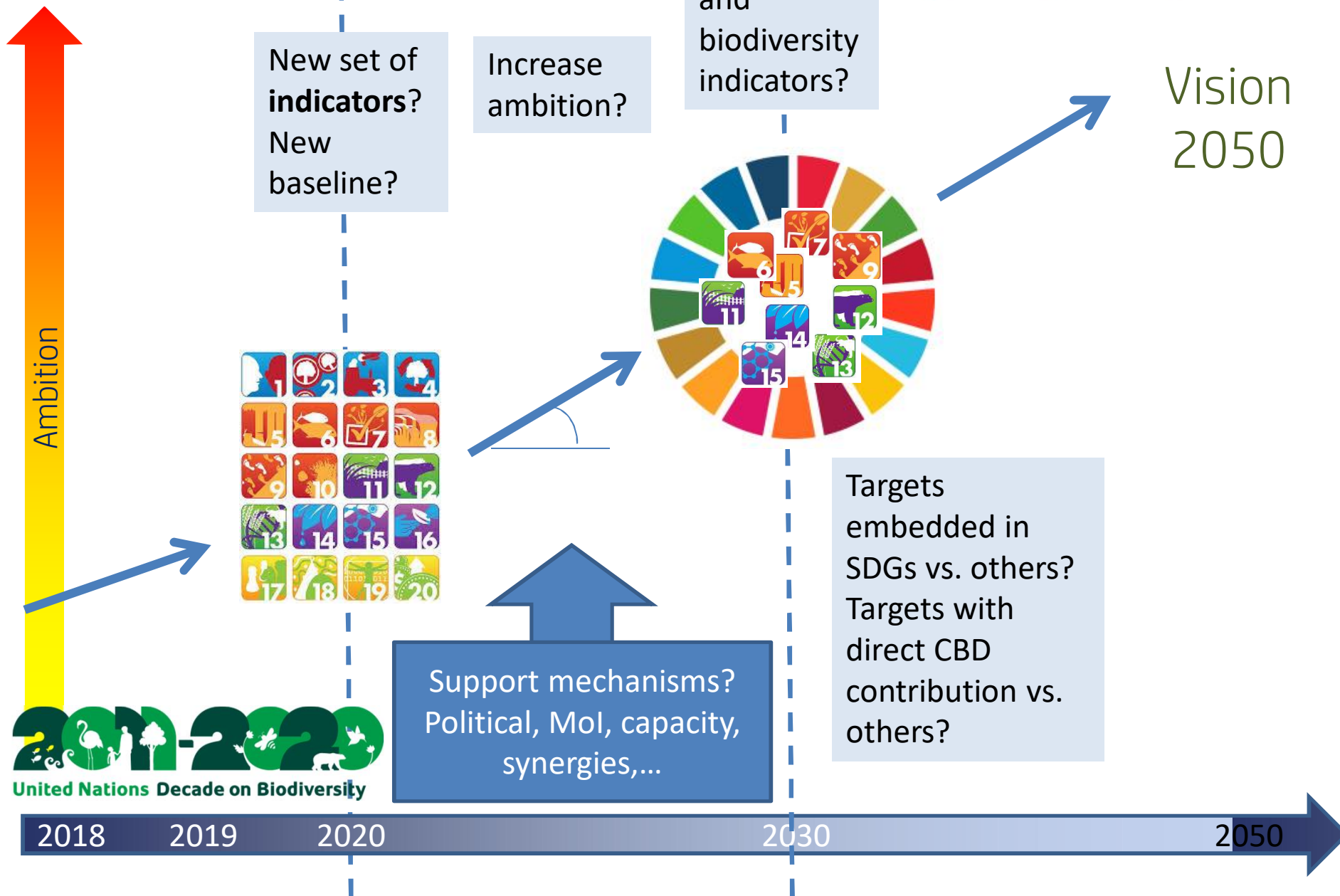

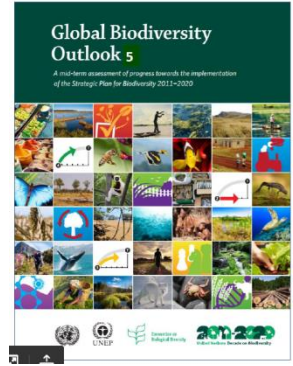

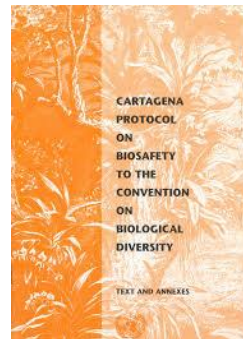
